Background

The COVID-19 pandemic has brought many Hong Kong families into hardships, especially to deprived families. Many of them are facing serious financial difficulties due to no-paid leaves and/or loss of jobs. Meanwhile, class suspension has limited the opportunity for individual development of youth and children. Moreover, continuous disease prevention measures has restricted families' activities and lead to a drastic drop of the quality of family life.

Funded by private donor and corporate, and supported by education and social service sectors, "Building Community, Building Tung Chung" ("The programme") has launched. Immediate assistance will be provided to successful applicants in form of scholarship, food vouchers and diversified online activities. It is to be hoped that this could help the families to tide over the hardship.

Students nomination guidelines

- Study in primary/secondary schools (including government aided schools and local schools under the Direct Subsidy Scheme) or kindergarten (under Kindergarten Education Scheme) in Tung Chung.
- Live in Public Rental Housing estates in Tung Chung (Fu Tung Estate, Yat Tung (I) Estate, Yat Tung (II) Estate, Ying Tung Estate or Mun Tung Estate).
- Come from low-income family. Nominated students will not be subject to asset test, nevertheless, it is hoped that schools could give priority to students from non-CSSA families whose parents became unemployed and/or income is significantly reduced because of the pandemic; or to students whose family is less capable of providing sufficient financial support to them under the current adversity, for example, students receiving financial assistance from the Student Finance Office.
- Have good conduct and good academic performance; participate actively in extra-curricular activities and community activities.
 - Have a positive attitude and persistence in the face of adversity; make efforts in their studies.
- Commit to participating in the associated activities of the programme at least once per month.
- Other students in need nominated by their respective school principals.

Details of assistance and disbursement arrangements

Scholarship: Students actively participating in the diversified online activities will receive approximately HK\$500 scholarship each month. Each student may receive the scholarship for maximum of 6 months, i.e. approximately HK\$3,000 in total. The scholarship will be transferred to the bank account of successful applicants directly or will be distributed through their schools.

Food vouchers: Students actively participate in the diversified online activities may receive food vouchers each month, which can be used in restaurants in Tung Chung. Each student may receive food vouchers for maximum of 6 months. The distribution arrangements of food vouchers will be announced later.

Diversified online activities: In partnership with 4 local NGOs, 6 online activities will be arranged each month. These include parent-child play sessions, home workout sports sessions and career chit-chat sessions etc. Through the online system, HKCSS will send invitations of the activities to students every month. Every participating student will receive a play set, a sport set and a reusable mask through their schools.
