**Gleeful E-learning Journey**

Thanks to the Hong Kong Bank (HSBC) Charity Fund that generously funded St. James' Settlement on promoting an e-Learning Support Scheme with “**Gleeful E-learning Journey**”. The scheme aims at supporting the online learning of primary to junior secondary students with free digital devices in order to enhance enhancing the digital literacy of students and parents.

Our school has been invited to participate in this scheme. The target beneficiaries include\*:

1.
